The middle college program in Guilford County Schools allows students to forego traditional high school for a magnet high school located on a college campus. These high schools have smaller classes, a great support structure and boast a 100% graduation rate! By their junior year in high school, students can take college classes and receive college credits. This automatically puts them on a college track after high school and gives them confidence in a college setting. The competition is fierce with only 25% of the applicants accepted. Out of our 8th grade class, 3 students were accepted, and 1 is on the waiting list. This acceptance rate was beyond our highest goal after only one year with these students.


Accepted to middle college at Bennett College
